Rod Stewart to light up the OLG Stage at Fallsview Casino in September

(Niagara Falls, ON) January 24, 2023 – He has put his extraordinary talents to use in the genres of pop, rock, folk, R&B, and disco. He was a guiding missile during the British Invasion, and has been a tireless solo artist over the span of decades. Today – some 60-plus years after bursting onto the world’s radar – Rod Stewart remains a performer who can fill music halls around the world.

On September 2, the legend himself will perform at Niagara Falls’ newest music venue: the 5,000-seat OLG Stage at Fallsview Casino.
