Rodrigo y Gabriela - In Between Thoughts...A New World Tour arrives at the Avalon Theatre

(Niagara Falls, ON) February 15, 2023 – The Grammy Award-winning duo Rodrigo y Gabriela hits the Avalon Theatre on July 2. The duo grew up listening to a unique blend of classic rock, heavy metal, and flamenco music. These influences are evident in their music to this day. This year sees the release of their most ambitious project yet, the Advaita Vedanta-inspired *In Between Thoughts...A New World*.
